Girls on the Run Summer Camp What You Need to Know...

Camp Hours

- Camp begins at 9:00 am and finishes at 4:00pm sharp!

Extended Hours

- Extended camp hours begin at 8:30am and finish at 5:00pm sharp!
- During the morning extended half hour campers will participate in a quiet GOTR activity.
- During the afternoon extended hour campers will participate in games not related to the GOTR curriculum

What to Bring to Camp

- Sunscreen and hats are mandatory
- Lunch – at GOTR we encourage healthy eating habits. Please send your camper with one snack and lunch that includes fruit and/or vegetables.
- GOTR is a NO PEANUT camp. Your child will be asked to eat in isolation from the group if there are peanut products in their snack or lunch.
- GOTR will provide a morning snack to all campers
- Water bottle – all campers require a water bottle with their name on it. Please fill bottle with water only.
- Running shoes are mandatory - each day your child will be participating in running activities, if a child does not have running shoes she will not be participating in the activities.
- Smock – required for craft time – large t-shirt works great.

Girls on the Run Summer Camp Code of Conduct and Camp Policies

Code of Conduct:

All campers are required to follow the code of conduct:

1. All campers will treat one another with respect
2. All campers must respect the property of the facility and of other campers
3. Teasing and bullying behavior will not be tolerated
4. Campers will be asked to leave Girls on the Run Summer Camp if they use violent language or behavior with campers or staff

Camp Policies:

1. Girls on the Run summer day camp is a peanut free environment. Please do not send your child with any peanuts or peanut products. If your child has peanuts or peanut products in their lunch or snacks, they will be permitted to eat in isolation of the rest of the campers.
2. Girls on the Run summer day camp needs to have all information on file with regards to any "special requirements" on the registration form if need. If there is any information about your child's individual needs that might be helpful to us we ask that you provide this information to us.
3. Girls on the Run summer day camp will not be responsible for lost or stolen items brought to camp. We suggest toys and games be left at home.
4. You will receive a confirmation letter upon registration along with your receipt. Girls on the Run summer day camp will require you to be on time for both the morning drop off time and the afternoon pick up time. We start the program promptly at 9:00am and finish at 4:00pm each day. Your child may miss important part of the day if they are not on time, it also causes a distraction to our program.
5. Girls on the Run summer camp has a sign in and sign out policy. Each morning the camper must be signed in by an adult and signed out. Please provide the Girls on the Run camp director with a list of all people who have permission to sign your child in and out from camp each day, or if another camper's parents will be the driver for the day.

6. If your child has sustained an illness or injury at Girls on the Run summer day camp we will follow the appropriate course of action which may include:
 - Calling a parent or emergency contact to pick up the child
 - Calling EMS to transport the child to the appropriate health care facility.
 - In all of these cases we will make every effort to get in touch with one or both parents.

7. Cancellation Policy – If you choose to cancel your registration for Girls on the Run summer day camp your refund will include the registration fee that you paid minus \$25.00 service charge.
